> How do I set up Outlook to check for messages every few
> minutes and automatically send messages? Right now, I
> can't receive or send anything without hitting the
> send/receive button. For example, when I try to send an
> email, it sits in my outbox until I hit send/receive. I
> have gone into tools-options-internet email and
> selected "check my local connections for new mail every
> __ minutes" but that doesn't seem to work.
>
> Now sometimes I try to send messages and they just sit in
> my Outbox. For example I had three messages that I
> wanted to send. I hit send/receive and only one was
> sent. I have hit send receive a bunch of times since
> then and there are still 2 unsent messages in my Outbox.
> I need to send these ASAP. What can I do to fix this?

> be Microsoft Outlook 2000 SP-3.
