Recently (since last week, end of June 2008), I get the yellow box on lower left side of browser saying "Working on your request...."

It actually stays on too long and Hotmail Live freezes, stops working or if I am very unlucky it will crash after writing an email for 30 minutes.

I pay for the full account and the Outlook connector so there is no reason for my Live account to work on any request.

I am currently working in another country (but problem not there before so I don't think is country related).

I suspect that it may be related to waiting to download and display ads or unwanted info from home country. Another nono if I pay for full services.

This last part is especulative but msn ads services seems to be having that effect around the net lately (so I am not alone in this idea).

----->questions:

1-is the message "working on your request" a temporary problem due to

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some

upgrading somewhere, or is it a thing to stay?

2-If so, will paying accounts also suffer from this?

3-If so, can someone suggest another webbased email service that will be adbot-tracking free (so no gmail) even if paying more than \$50 a year? (I already use Yahoo premium for anotyher account, so no Yahoo either).
