Hi, I am using Entourage 2004 v 11.2.1 on Mac OS X v 10.3.9

I have a two part question.

1. I have a group of people over 100 who I send out my monthly newsletters. I have my subscribers as a group in my address book. When I send out my newsletter, I put my other email address (not the one that I am sending from) in TO field and put the group in BCC. Some of my subscribers tell me that my email goes to their junk folder. I have even broken the group to several smaller groups and it still doesn't seem to solve the problem. Is there a script or a way to send a group email to INDIVIDUAL addresses so the recipient will have his/her own email address in TO field automatically? I have my own SMTP so do not have a restriction of the size of recipients

2. I have been using Paul Berkowitz's Complex HTML X script (adapted from the script for Outlook Express by Steven Friesen) to send a complex HTML newsletter. It's been working very well and I am very happy and thankful to both Paul and Steven. So is there a way to send a group COMPLEX HTML email to INDIVIDUAL addresses automatically?
