I have now set it for Hong Kong, and this seems to take care of the display problem for new events. Preexisting events are still displayed improperly. Anyone know how to fix this? Thanks.

Since you've discovered that your Entourage was set to an incorrect time zone and you've basically entered all your information under the incorrect time zone, I would think you'll need to manually adjust each of the incorrect events. Going forward, obviously, shouldn't be a problem.

I believe my Entourage was set to an incorrect time zone for only a few minutes right after I installed Apple's DST Update. The problem was immediately obvious. I don't think I entered any new events during this period.

The events that are displaying improperly were input well before I installed the Apple update. When I open them individually, I find the time in each event is accurate; it's just that they are being displayed inaccurately. Inside each event is a banner that reads:

Event time zone: Perth (Displayed)
Your computer's time zone: Asia/Hong_Kong

I had this same problem before Apple released its Panther DST update when I briefly installed an unofficial DST update (from Ian Ward Comfort at Stanford University <<http://www.stanford.edu/~icomfort/panthertz/patch-panthertz.sh>>). The problem disappeared as soon as I uninstalled the unofficial DST update.

I'd gladly uninstall the Apple update, but I everything I read says it's a must-have. My computer overall seems to be fine. The only problem is with Entourage. Perhaps an 11.3.5 update would solve the problem?
