As I understand it: The End User License Agreement (EULA) permits you to install using the same product key on one Desktop & one Laptop system per license. You are permitted to *run* the software on only one of those systems at a time. So based on what I can tell from your message you should be able to just install Office 2008 on the second system.

If you're disposing of the first system you should run the Remove Office utility in order to retain the license. If you sell or give the system with Office installed to someone else you're obligated surrender the license to that individual – otherwise they'll be using the product illegally. If you do include the software & license, however, you're obligated to remove Office from the system you keep – you'll have to buy a new copy if you want to continue using Office legally.
