Thanks. My d drive is in the same location, but I'm unfamiliar with OS X Finder (I'm still new to the Mac World). If I use the Apple O (Open) command it merely opens the Virtual PC list. Am I doing this correctly?

If I follow Paul's tip, which was to solve a different error message, I find that there is no file called 'savedstate'.

Thanks incidentally, it's due to your web site that I found this forum.

<home>/documents/Virtual PC List/Virtual PC Drive.vhdp  
I can open it with OS X Finder PROVIDED that when it was last  
used VPC was shutdown rather than SAVED STATE (I just found  
this out accidentally - normally I dont use saved state).

If shared folders would do this then that would be great if I could find out how to set them up.

I do need to salvage D "drive" though.

John wrote:

It's not exactly 3 virtual machines that I have, as D + F are Virtual Hard Disk Documents and not Virtual PC documents. Having extra 'drives' is quite standard Windows policy and was the only way to go due to fixed paths in some legendary software installed. Sorry if I explained it incorrectly.

I have already experienced the problems with saved state files, but one hardly ex
