I have Virtual PC 7.0.3 on my iMac G5 (PPC) running OS X 10.4.11, and I run Windows XP Professional within VPC.

I have a language CD that I used to run on a Windows PC which needs Windows 95, 98 or NT 4.0. I uninstalled it from the old PC some time ago when I sold it, and have recently tried to install it on this version of XP but without success.

Can I install Windows 98 SE on my VPC in addition to XP? As far as I can see, I do this by Selecting File – New, Create New PC, and Install your own Operating System. If so, could anyone advise me on the best place to buy a second-hand copy? I am a bit hesitant about buying such software on eBay since I can't be sure it is legit, and cannot find such an old OS anywhere else. I am in the UK.

The other choice I have is that I have a dying laptop with Windows 98SE on it. Could I transfer that, perhaps via a USB stick? (There's no CD drive on the laptop so it was not installed via a CD.)
