Hi,

I used the following steps for a 720p TS source. It possibly works for 1080i, but not for my streams.

1. Convert the TS to DVR–MS using TSConverter. This step just changes the container format. The elementary streams are kept.
2. Open the DVR–MS file in WME and encode using a HD profile.

The encoding parameters significantly determine the sharpness and PQ. You have to fine tune to get best results.

I can provide a 720p sample, if needed.
