MP3. mvp or wave sound – error – " Windows Media Player encountered an unknown error. This can occur when another program or operating system component encounters a problem but does not communicate the nature of the problem to the Player".

Guess that is what I get now instead of the quartz dll. being missing or the code being missing or corrupt. This error gives no explanation, just says its unknown. So, how do you fix an unknown???? :-)
