> freezes. By clicking CTL-ALT-DEL, I can see the CPU usage is at 100%,  
> when  
> it normally is at 4-5%. If I try playing the same MPEG2 video from another  
> computer it works, although it's a little slow (video size = 4MB).  
>  
> I can play a .WMV file from another website, and it works fine. I can also  
> play MPEG2 files from my computer without a problem.

> Is there something wrong with my player, security settings, file size,  
> website, etc.?
