> from scratch and then install Windows Media Player 10. Everything now
> works. I would really like to see though a different solution to this

> This is a VERY FRUSTRATING problem. I pity anyone who has it. If
> anyone would like more info about this problem in order to maybe
> attempt to offer a solution, go ahead and post your questions here.
> The main problems are that it prevented me from upgrading to Windows
> Media Player 10, from repairing Windows Media Player, since my version
> 9 got messed up, and from playing any kind of content (when I was able
> to get Media Player truly installed by right clicking on the .wmp10.inf
> file and selecting install, because by running the setup file it would
> not install, even though part of the contradictory statement says that
> it was installed—"Cannot complete windows media player 10 setup. It
> was not possible to complete setup. Windows media player was installed
> successfully.") that required a license because instead of asking to
> download the license and presenting me with a window for me to enter my
> username and password, I would instead get an unexpected error has
> occurred message.
