Thank you for replying, but if I understand you correctly, I do have videos saved on the hard-drive, (mpegs) but some that I receive in e-mail, when I click on them, I receive the pop-up error message "0xC00D1197" & the other error message is "0xC00D1199". I do know that the clips are valid, because other on line friends can open them & no problem. I also tried disabling the firewall, spysweeper, etc but still get the error messages. New pc, dsl connection, & Ive checked all settings in wmp settings, all file extensions are selected. Im running windows xp, sp2 with IE 6. WMP version 10. Thanks again & I appreciate any ideas for fixing these two error messages that I get "very often" on valid clips that others can open.
