ffdshow-xxx-sse.exe for Micro with SSE, (AMD Athlon XP, AMD Duron 1GHz, Pentium III, Celeron PIII.)

ffdshow-sse2.exe for Micro with SSE2, e.x. Pentium IV.

ffdshow-xxxx.exe the rest

download your file and install, then start/all

programs/ffdshow/configuration/codecs: check in the left and go to the right

scroll down choose libcodec
