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I have now seen a few times that codec packs are bad for WMP 11 in Vista. I think it is about time that Microsoft make a big issue of this and tell people clearly that this will happen, especially when there is a Vista Codec Pack floating around which seems to have done the same to my player and I can't recover it. Please tell people clearly to not install either the K-Lite codecs or the Vista Codec Pack. Having said this, there still does seem to be a problem with WMP 11 in Vista not playing certain files which WMP11 in XP would play
