Check to see if MS Office XP is listed in Add/Remove Programs.
If so you can use 'Change' do run a 'Repair/Reinstall' with the original CD. If it's not listed run setup from the Office CD to repair or reinstall as needed.

You can also use Start=>Search to look for Winword.exe to find the location of the Word program, for example. It's possible that the shortcuts to the apps are simply not showing up in the current user profile (i.e. try logging in as Admin/Owner).
