Hi everyone,

Our company uses the Microsoft Volume License, and we have a portal via Microsoft.com to download our MS software. Today when checking out MS Office 2007, there are two options for Microsoft Enterprise:

Office Enterprise 2007 Win32 English Disk Kit MVL DVD English  
2006-11-30

Office Enterprise 2007 Win32 English Disk Kit MVL UG Only DVD  
English  
2006-11-30

The first one is around 500 Megs and the latter (UG Only) is almost 2 Gigs. I'd assume the UG Only means Upgrade Only, but if so why would the Upgrade be 2 Gigs with the full version only 500 Megs?

Can someone shed some light on this for us? I'll probably download both just to be sure, but just checking.
