> a repair install of Office 2003 not the fresh install.

> Now the runtime errors have returned, and I assume that I'll start losing
my
> internet connection for IE again. Although it's not yet happened since
I've
> just recently reinstalled Office and enough time hasn't elapsed.

> install?
