I'm afraid I can't shed light on that error other than saying that the  
WDBIMP.dll should be there. Is it there in your folder structure?

One suggestion. Try running Setup but select the advanced option and  
try only installing one product. That may allow you to get something  
installed but I'm not sure which installs depend on that DLL.
