I also have another post on Windows Vista General Discussion about not being able to install 3 Office updates, XML update and SQL server update with error message 80200053. Extracting file failed. It is most likely caused by low memory (low disk space for swapping files) or corrupted cabinet file.

I have tried to install these files individually from Windows Update and then directly from the actual update page with no luck. The Office Updates are: 935569, 937068 and 934173.

Since some of my problems are with Office updates, does anyone have any ideas on how to get these updates installed?
