Same here re not knowing what to recommend for a quick fix. I'm wondering if it's a video driver issue, though. I'd probably see if updating the video driver and changing hardware acceleration helps. Those are fairly painless things to try, although I'd be sure to set a restore checkpoint (if using Windows XP) before updating the video driver.
