I hope someone can help with this. I have created a monogram for our wedding in Powerpoint. Used first name Last intial first name. I learned this from the internet, but the font I used Sheer Elegance only goes up to 96 size.

The pre-supplied sizes only go up to 96, but you can type higher values into the text size box.

When I am finished and click Save...what should I save it as?

I want to use this monogram on my invites reply cards, programs etc. that I have created in Word 2000.

Save it as a normal PowerPoint file before you do anything else. You may need to open and edit it again.

You should be able to select the graphics, choose Edit, Copy then switch to Word and Edit, Paste Special, as EMF.

But it seems everytime I insert it in Word I can't resize it the way I want.
