What is the easiest way to enable a powerpoint presentation to show multiple page pdf files that have been imported into a presentation as an object.

The normal view show the pdf file and when I click on it acrobat opens up and I can show both pages. However, when playing the full screen slide show the double click on the document does not open up acrobat. I guess I could separate the pdf into separate pages and incorporate each page into a slide. Hopefully, there is an easier way to accomplish this without separating out all the documents.

Don't insert as object ... simply create a link to the PDF and it should work as you want it to from a PPT slide show.
