I am running SBS 2000 with W2K clients and Office 2003.

We have a public calendar and a public contacts folder.

On various machines we have been losing these from the favourites list and on one occasion the public calendar appeared under the contacts section. I then had to remove it and re-add.

Also, it would be nice for the machine to remember that you had the public calendar open and to show the side-by-side view automatically when you next log in.
