Hi Balaji--

We narrowed down the issue. The issue only occurs when we attempt to send mail outside of our domain and is being caused by TrendMicro's "ScanMail for Lotus Notes" version 2.51 running on our AS400. Once we shut ScanMail down we were able to successfully send an external email message. I was emailing back and forth with another user from newsgroups and his company is using Scanmail as well. It appears that ScanMail for Lotus Notes blocks email that is going outside the domain because of some field in the note has the wrong datatype (Or so it thinks.)

The support from Trendmicro is terrible so I don't foresee that we'll be able to resolve this issue with them unless you figure out a workaround.
