> has changed. I noticed that asp files are now blocked. They became
unblocked

> after I added asp to the Level1Remove registry value. The asp extension
was

> previously blocked by default. I was able to confirm this with PSS, which
> provided this page as the ONLY documentation which has been updated with
> correct information:
