to run updated Canon software I need to resolve the missing sku111.cab problem. Machine is Toshiba, media edition xp – factory install of software. Only disks I have are Recovery or Update. I am unable to locate B21654A.exe where this file is residing on either disk.

MS offers 3 ways to workaround/resolve the missing file but they all presuppose the victim having a full Office disk, even in the LIS tool procedure, all found in related
