Frank, in OL 2003 you could add a rule that handles all incoming messages and determine via the Rule Wizard that a script should be executed. Create a function in "ThisOutlookSession", which needs to look like this:

```
Public Sub DoSomething(oMail as Outlook.MailItem)
....
End Sub
```

Within the function check the MailItem.SenderEmailAddress property. If it doesn't match what you're looking for then move the message into DeletedItems and delete it.
