> *I have a similar problem. Trying to import from Netscape 6.2 into Outlook 2003. I have found that older versions of Netscape can be imported into Outlook Express and can then be imported by Outlook. In my version of Netscape , the email data was stored in the Windows directory beginning with .../Application Data/Mozilla/my netscape username/... All the files and folders on mine were over 450MB (includes email attachments, I guess) The address book has a .mab extension where Outlook wanted a .nab Anyone who discovers a fix for this is a hero.*

Address book – export as LDIF which Outlook can import.

Mail – Download and install either Netscape 4.x (preferred because of attachment issues) or Eudora.

Copy all your mail files from NS 6 (the ones WITHOUT the extension) into your new mail client. launch the mail client. open each mail file. This will build the index files.

Then, in Outlook, do the import.
