>> delete the partnership and recreate it.

>> To delete and recreate the partnership --

>>

>> 1. Disconnect the ipaq from the computer.

>> 2. In Activesync -> File -> Delete Partnership.

>> 3. Connect the device and follow the onscreen

>> instructions to setup a new partnership.

>> 4. When the Combine or Replace dialog appears, choose the Combine (1st)

>> option. ActiveSync should detect the duplicates and prompt you to remove

>> them.

>> You can check your birthday/anniversary dates and check if there any

>> duplicates.

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
