Any thoughts on how this can be fixed? It would appear to be an unforeseen architecture issue. I've got a Windows Mobile 2003 device sitting on the same PC that works perfectly and yet the new architecture which uses already in use (VPN) IP addresses to communicate will not communicate.

What I'm finding even more interesting is that Bluetooth appears to work almost as flawlessly as the USB connection on my WM 2003 device. [I saw almost as occasionally I'm having to reconfigure the connection on the WM 5 device. It's as if it loses the configuration info]

Is this a beginning of support for WUSB connectivity to desktops/laptops?
