> Guys, I'm a little confused by this thread. It sounds to me like Alexander
> is using POP3. POP3 is really designed for use with a single email
package.

> You can tell it to leave the messages on the server and that will let you
> download the same mail to different locations, but its not really designed
> for all that.

>

> IMAP is specifically designed for the mail to reside on the server and
> synchronize changes from more than one location. When I read a message on
> either the PC or the PPC, it gets marked as read on the server and then
> marked as read on the other platform. Same thing when I delete a message.

I

> can delete the SPAM from my PPC, even after that same SPAM has been
> downloaded to my PC, and when I resync on the PC that SPAM is removed. I
> just tried this. I'm using an iPAQ 4155 with WM2003FE and a WinXP SP2
laptop

> with Outlook Express 6.x.

I
> >> read a message at work (one that has already been read and downloaded

> >> home) and I delete it (and hit purge deleted items) then the message is

> >> from the server perminantly). Using my Axim, I see the same messages

> >> are still on my server even after the POP3 account has downloaded them

> >> if I hit delete the message moves to the deleted folder on my Axim, but

> >> is not deleted on the server. In fact, if I empty the deleted folder on
