> iPAQ 5450 has Intel X-Scale PXA250 processor and iPAQ 2210 has PXA255 – both
> running at 400MHz. But PXA255 is much faster. The PXA250 is so slow that
> even old devices with StrongARM 206MHz CPU have better performance.
>
> Unfortunately the only way to speed your device up is to use some software
> which will overclock the CPU. But the battery life will hurt then.
>
