>to lose the signal and not regain it automatically when back in a good
>reception area. I then have to switch the phone off and back on again
>manually. This is very urrutating as I assume the phone is on when it's
>not. Also irritating for people trying to phone me.*

Before turning off and on again, try this trick. Select Settings, Phone then the Network tab. Tap the Set Preferred Network button. This almost always enables my XDA1 to find the signal again. Strangely the Find Network button on the same page has no effect!
