>>> automatically adjust its clock at the Daylight Savings Time change. In

>>> it did not "spring forward" and this past weekend it did not "fall
>>> back".

>>> I searched various discussion forums, even called HP, and no one gave me
>>> a
>>> cogent answer as to why this would happen. In fact, at first the HP
>>> support
>>> person told me I had to sync my iPaq before it would make the time
>>> change –
>>> which is not only a step backwards from Pocket PC 2000, but is a silly
>>> idea
>>> when you think about those of us who depend on timely alarms!

>>> *Yes, I have the iPaq set to the correct time zone, and yes, both the*
>>> *settings for the system clock and the Outlook settings are checked to*
>>> *automatically adjust for Daylight Savings Time, and I am using the*
>>> *latest*
>>> *version of ActiveSync...all of which is pointless anyway, if the iPaq is*
>>> *supposed to make the time adjustment on its own.*

>>> *There are no settings I can find anywhere in WM2003 to tell the unit it*
>>> *has*
>>> *to adjust for DST.*

>>> *So, any ideas of what might be wrong here? Any help, leads would be*
