My original set up was to synchronizer on connect, and it does. Your suggestion to cancel the 'would you like to combine items' dialog, never appears.

The synchronize with server checkbox has never been checked.

I can't find 'desynchronise' the calendar anywhere.

I'm going to un check it as one of the items to sync, then see if I can make it do it on my own after notes and contacts do their thing.

Is there a later version of activesync that I should be using?

Seems like this thing was written for management to keep up with you, not for you to configure as needed so as to be able keep yourself up to date :{

>Let it start to sync one last time and then cancel the 'would you like
>to combine items' dialog. Go to Activesync Tools->Options->Sync
>Options tab, and look down the bottom.

>See the unintuitively labelled 'server options' ? Go there (click
>Configure) and uncheck the 'Calendar' icon. No, I don't know why it's
>not listed on the main screen of sync items, either ;-p

>

>If you prefer to sync the items on the PPC back to the PC however,
>instead go to the 'Rules' tab, and make sure the "Desktop" dropdown is

>set to 'Always replace the items on this computer'. If you're using an
>exchange server, maybe you'll have to do the same to the dropdown
>below that too (I've never tried)
