>I'm having a problem with signing a driver and load it on a Windows
>Mobile 5.0 device. I'm trying to use the Windows Mobile 5 SDK sample
>certificates. Here is what I exactly do:
>
>I copy the SdkCerts.cab file to the device and open it in File
>Explorer.
>
>In Visual Studio 2005 I do the following:
> 1.On the Project menu, click Properties.
> 2.Click Authenticode Signing.
> 3.For the Authenticode Signature property, click Yes.
> 4.For the Certificate property, click the Ellipses (...) button.
> 5.In the Select Certificate dialog box, choose the
>SDKSamplePrivDeveloper.pfx certificate.
> 6.On the Authenticode Signing page, click OK.
>
>Then I copy my driver (.dll) to the device and reboot it but it still
>won't load. I've also tried with the unprivileged certificate but with
>the same result. Can anyone help me with what to do or give me a hint
>of how to solve this problem?
>
>Any kind of help would be really appreciated.
