It may be because they switch to https (and, then, back) upon the first login – at least this is the case with Yahoo. I'm absolutely sure the problem is with the COnnectivity framework (that is, it thinks it has a HTTPS (webmail) and Socks (MSN Messenger) proxy even if it doesn't display it) and

Try backing up the badly behaving PDA, hard reset and see wwhether, then, you're able to connect.
