Questions about programming are far more likely to get useful answers if asked in a newsgroup for programmers. If you are using a .NET language (C# or VB.NET), try using google (http://groups.google.com/advanced_group_search) to look up cf database (cf stands for Compact Framework). I just did and got 109,000 hits. I didn't look closely, but saw leads to at least one appropriate newsgroup. If you are not using a .NET language, then microsoft.public.pocketpc.developer would be appropriate. Once you find a newsgroup, I suggest using google to look up database in that newsgroup.
