You might want to apply the SDHC hack I've discussed on my blog on Sunday. It MIGHT help (or not).

Has anybody done this to an axim X51v rom 12?
I'd like to have sdhc support so I can use it to see if a card is counterfeit before I buy it, but i'm not willing to brick my axim.

The directions say to overwrite two dll's. I decided I'd save the originals just in case. Totalcommander says it's copying the files, but they're not in the destination directory.
And with the persistent memory, a hard reset isn't gonna put back the old dll's after I replace 'em ???? yes? no?
I guess the real question is, "does the X51v even have a "rom" in the classical sense?
If I go diddling around in the operating system part of the flash, can I reverse it?
I haven't tried overwriting the dll's, but I'm guessing that Total commander is gonna have the same problem as copying them???
