> password, they get a error—"Your account does not have permissions to  
> log on. You need to change the account in your profile or contact your  
> server administrator to give your account permissions to log on to  
> this server. (5016)". I know that they have permissions on the server

> I have added the server site to the trusted sites list. I have enabled  
> ActiveX controls. Not sure what else to do at this point. Can  
> someone help?
