Thanks for the help – but I mis-spoke. The print preview shows the exact same problem as the print output. This has been tested on hard copy print devices, Adobe Acrobat and PDF995. Tested on 3 different PCs with the same results.

All 3 PCs (XP Pro SP2) have Project Standard 2007 SP1 installed. 2 installs were upgrades, 1 was a new installation – again exact same results.

Project 2007 SP1, Print Preview displays as expected. FAQ 44 no help. Print to HP hardcopy or .pdf with Acrobat 8 yeilds same result. Tested on 3 different PCs with same Project installed – all results the same. Horizontal lines still missing from bar style.
