- > Looks to me like the form itself is fully functional and the confirmation
- > page is technically functional.
- > it's just that the Frontpage header and footer text is not rendered
- > properly.
- > which isn't is really a "problem" it just looks bad.
- > so this is a FrontPage Server Extensions (FPSE) issue not Publisher.
- > so... I recommend as a first course of action you put in a order with the
- > host to reinstall FPSE.
- > the host support should know that FPSE are easily corrupted, usually from
- > the user making ftp connections instead of http, and so they should be used
- > to reinstall requests.
- > fwiw if they give you any crap my web host recommendation is listed on
- > www.davidbartosik.com .
- > if the reinstall fails to clear it up then I can only refer you to post the
- > url of the form page to the Frontpage forum at
- > microsoft.public.frontpage.client and ask in that forum what could cause
- > this issue.
