If you are sending something like a newsletter for information and not as something the recipient would need to open and edit... the best way to send it would be to go File, Send E-mail, Send This Page As Message and then it will appear in the body of the email message and not as an attachment.

We use this method for sending out our office newsletter and it quite happily opens in Outlook, Hotmail, Yahoo etc and on computers that do not have Publisher installed.
