Actually, I did 'save as webpage' in Pub 2000 – that was what caused the problem. The answer I got from Microsoft for that issue was not to 'save as webpage' any file you wanted to also keep as PUB. They assured me that 2007 would not have this problem.

In this case I did choose 'publish as a PDF' – which I was perhaps unclear on – to produce a PDF. I assumed the original PUB file would be unchanged by the process but have found that not to be the case; it has made the file single page and I can't figure how to get it back to double page.

It wouldn't be a problem except that my newsletter has pages that carry over from one issue to the next. Last month I had to recreate the whole thing because I couldn't figure out how to change it back to a two page spread. I don't want to have to do that every month.
