When you double-click on it, you are running with logged-on user's rights. Thus, "current user" is what you expect it to be. When running with admin rights, it is under a different context.....

> I reg key in current users (to point Word 2000 at a certain location  
> for shared templates. Once compiled, this EXE runs perfectly well if  
> run by double clicking, however if I create a package containing this  
> program and advertise it, it doesn't work. SMS returns a error code  
> of zero and states that the program has completed successfully on the  
> targets, but the registry remains unchanged. For testing purposes I  
> am using 1 distribution point and am running it hidden with no user  
> interaction, also with admin rights.....*
