> What you are seeing is that remote.exe is not able to map the name you

>are providing to it to an SMS resource ID, so it can't check the SMS

>database and see if you have rights to remote control that system.

>

> If you are using remote.exe outside of the sms admin console, you can use

>the /SMS:NOSQL switch to prevent it from checking for the security.

>Obviously there are some security concerns here, you don't want remote.exe

>to spread too widely in your company.
