I have a really strange problem. I have setup a new sms site so we now have 2 sites, the boundaries are set by subnets. I have successfully installed the advanced client onto 2 machines, and depolyed software. I have just used some 3rd party tools to initiate the hardware and software from the console. However it didn't work. When I open system management in the control panel, all the system properties have disappeared apart from the ones that start sms. I've checked the inventory agent log and there are some errors about the netbios name. I rebooted the pc, but now I can't ping or browse to it and when I log on, the task bar is minimised and locked! some how I managed to get the task bar back but when I open say control panel it doesn't show in the task bar and also there is nothing at all in the system properties or the other tabs. Automatic site discovery isn't successfully either although it has been in the past!
