I'm having no luck at all.

I also tried the HCU\Environment and HCU\Volatile Environment keys with no luck.

I wrote a .vbs script (which works as described in the KB article) and paused it in the middle so I could search the registry. There is nothing in the registry!!!

The "Unblock" security button in the General Properties of each patch seems to be the most promising right now. I haven't figured out why that property does not appear on all patches yet. Some of the Adobe Reader patch files have it and some don't.
