We have the exact same error. Deploying to about 250 machines and we have had about 3 of these occurrences. No information as to why (apart from your input) and no solution other than to run msicleaner and re-install – (a REAL pain since we need to do the SP's as well.) – Interested in any replies.

> What happens is that on the client machines certain Apps installed using
> msixec e.g MS office fail to run with various error messages. The only way
> we have found to recover the client is to run the msicleaner and then
> reinstall office or whatever fails to run. The event log on the client shows
> a lot of errors relating to unknown apps (long strings of numbers) It may
> be related to the hardware scan maybe not is there a way SMS is updating or
> changing the msixec. I have only installed the client no other software
> being deployed yet.
