I also have 2 forests with a 2 way transitive trust between the domains, sms is running in advanced security mode. Wins is configured

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with the site information, and I have setup the security on the smsclient share as well as the ntfs permissions. When I try to deploy the Advanced Client to workstations in the other domain that the sms server is not located in, I get the following error.

Failed to find accessible source. Waiting for retry. and \\servername\smsclient\i386 is inaccessible.
